

ORDINANCE NO. 2994

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE FOR THE TERMS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2012, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, based upon the results of the 2010 federal decennial census, the Secretary of State declared that the City of Crestline had become the Village of Crestline effective April 30, 2011, and

WHEREAS, this date was after the date set by R.C. 713.13 to establish salary for elected Village officials, and

WHEREAS, no valid Ordinance has been enacted fixing the compensation of Village officials and no valid Ordinance could have been enacted by the prior City Council as the only authority to set salaries for Village elected officials is a Village Council, which did not exist prior to January 1, 2012, and

WHEREAS, the compensation set by this Ordinance is the same as was paid in 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That effective for the term of office which commenced on January 1, 2012, the compensation of Village officials is hereby established as follows:

Mayor: \$8,500.00 per annum
Council Members: \$3,480.00 per annum

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate effective date of this Ordinance is necessary so that Village officials can be paid in a timely manner, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
