

ORDINANCE NO. 2999

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF JOSEPH BUTLER AS CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE FOR A SIX MONTH PROBATIONARY TERM EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Joseph Butler Chief of Police of the Village of Crestline, and

WHEREAS, R.C. 737.15 requires this appointment to be confirmed by this Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the appointment of Joseph Butler as Chief of Police of the Village of Crestline for a six month probationary term as provided in R.C. 737.17, effective immediately, is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate effective date of this Ordinance is necessary so that the Village Police Department can function effectively as soon as possible, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
