

ORDINANCE NO. 3002

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.05 OF THE VILLAGE PERSONNEL POLICY AND PROCEDURE MANUAL TO INCREASE THE CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR POLICE OFFICERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2012, Crestline Village Council passed Ordinance No. 2992, thereby adopting a revised Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual for the Village of Crestline, and

WHEREAS, the police officer uniform allowance established in the superseded Collective Bargaining Agreement was \$750.00 per year, and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator of the Village of Crestline recommends to Crestline Village Council a revision to the Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual, Section 7.05, so as to provide for a clothing allowance for police officers of \$750.00 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Crestline Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual, Section 7.05, is hereby amended to provide for a clothing allowance for police officers of \$750.00 per year as recommended by the Village Administrator.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate effective date of this Ordinance is necessary so as to fairly reimburse police officers for uniform expenses at the same level as in the recent

past, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
