

ORDINANCE NO. 3006

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FROM CONSTRUCTION COMPANIES AND TO ENTER INTO ALL AGREEMENTS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE HAMILTON PARK RESTROOM PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline is planning to repair and construct a new restroom at Hamilton Park, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline has applied for monies from CDBG for financial assistance to fund the project, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline has been awarded a grant through Crawford County CDBG to fund this project, and

WHEREAS, Crawford County has approved the project and shall pay for the project using CDBG funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Crestline, Ohio:

SECTION 1 That the Village Administrator of the Village of Crestline is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids from construction companies necessary for the completion of the Hamilton Park restroom project.

SECTION 2 That the Village Administrator is further authorized to negotiate and enter into any agreements or contracts as may be necessary and appropriate in completing this project.

SECTION 3 That it is hereby determined that this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of residents in this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to ensure timely project completion and this ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council.
