

ORDINANCE NO. 3008

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTED WITH RESPECT TO THE OPERATION OF CITY WATER WELL NUMBER ONE AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH OHIO DRILLING COMPANY TO REPAIR THE SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, R.C. 735.051 authorizes the awarding of a contract without competitive bidding when there exists a real and present emergency in the operation or maintenance of a municipally-owned public utility, and

WHEREAS, a real and present emergency existed with respect to water well number one which required its immediate repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO, TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION 1. That a contract is hereby awarded to Ohio Drilling Company for recent repairs to water well number one which included the pulling of the pump and installation of a new bowl assembly.

SECTION 2. That payment for this work in the sum of \$28,862.00 from the Water Pumping appropriation in the Village Water Fund is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the approval of this contract is necessary so as to be able to pay for work already completed on an emergency basis, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council,

otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
