

ORDINANCE NO. 3015

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO R.C. 735.052 AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE A USED MOTOR VEHICLE FOR HIS USE ON VILLAGE BUSINESS AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is in need of a vehicle to drive on Village business, and

WHEREAS, R.C. 735.052 authorizes the Village to purchase a used vehicle without the necessity of competitive bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to purchase a used motor vehicle for his use on Village business at a cost not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

SECTION 2. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to pay for the cost of this vehicle from the proper account as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate effective date of this Ordinance is necessary so that the transportation needs of the Village Administrator on Village business can be met as soon as possible, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
