

ORDINANCE NO. 3018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH MIDWEST COMPOST, INC. FOR THE DEWATERING AND DISPOSAL OF SLUDGE FROM THE VILLAGE SEWER TREATMENT PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline is required to meet the requirements of the Ohio EPA dealing with the sewage sludge accumulated from daily usage at the Village Sewer Treatment Plant, and

WHEREAS, the Village does not have access to any fields to apply land application of the sewage sludge, and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that it is necessary to contract with Midwest Compost, Inc. to assist the Village in dewatering and transporting sludge to a disposal site for a period not to exceed one year or until the plant modifications are completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to contract with Midwest Compost, Inc. to dewater and transport sludge from the Village Sewer Treatment Plant.

SECTION 2. That the fee for services under this contract includes a set-up fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) and an operational cost of \$0.065 per gallon, provided however that the set-up fee will be waived if 500,000 gallons of sludge are dewatered within a 12 month period.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to ensure timely compliance with Ohio EPA regulations and orders, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
