

ORDINANCE NO.3027

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH OHIO EDISON COMPANY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SIX STREET LIGHTS TO BE LOCATED ON COLBY ROAD AND SOUTH WILEY STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, several residents within the corporation limits of Crestline have requested an improvement in the street lighting on parts of Colby Road and South Wiley Street, and

WHEREAS, in order to meet this need, the Village of Crestline has requested that Ohio Edison provide a proposal for the installation of six (6) additional street lights to be located along Colby Road and South Wiley Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to sign an agreement with Ohio Edison to install six (6) additional street lights along Colby Road and South Wiley Street in accordance with its proposal.

SECTION 2. That the cost for this installation shall be paid out of the Capital Improvements Fund and shall not exceed the sum of Four Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-five Dollars and Fifty-one Cents (\$4,225.51).

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to ensure timely project completion, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members

elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
