

ORDINANCE NO. 3028

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THIS VILLAGE TO SIGN THE RENEWAL OF A MUTUAL AID FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS WITH THE VILLAGE OF NEW WASHINGTON, CRAWFORD COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline desires to continue the Mutual Aid Fire Protection Agreement with the Village of New Washington, Crawford County, Ohio, with the goal of maximizing public safety for the citizens of both communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the Village of Crestline is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Mutual Aid Fire Protection Agreement for a term of five years with the Village of New Washington, Crawford County, Ohio, a copy of which is attached hereto as EXHIBIT A and fully incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to ensure the continued availability of mutual aid for fire protection, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
