

ORDINANCE NO. 3041

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PART OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF CRESTLINE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Crestline, Ohio; and

Whereas, numerous sections of the Traffic, and General Offenses, Fire Prevention Codes should be updated to comply with enactments passed by the General Assembly in the past year.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the council of the Village of Crestline, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Crestline, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to-wit:

SECTION 4 That it is hereby determined that this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of residents in this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to ensure timely project completion and this ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council.
