

ORDINANCE NO. 3052

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 181.07(a) CREDIT FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THIS VILLAGE BY INCREASING THE CREDIT FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY FROM ONE AND ONE-QUARTER PERCENT(1-1/4%) TO ONE AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (1-1/2%).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT Section 181.07(a) of the Codified Ordinances of this Village which reads as follows:

- (a) Where a resident is subject to municipal income tax in another municipality, he shall be allowed a credit against the tax imposed by this chapter of the amount so paid by him or in his behalf to such other municipality. The credit shall not exceed one and one-quarter percent (1¼%) on such income earned in such other municipality where such tax is paid.

Is hereby repealed and enacted in its place is a new Section 181.07(a) which reads as follows:

- (a) Where a resident is subject to municipal income tax in another municipality, he shall be allowed a credit against the tax imposed by this chapter of the amount so paid by him or in his behalf to such other municipality. The credit shall not exceed one and one-half percent (1½%) on such income earned in such other municipality where such tax is paid.

SECTION 2. THAT the intent of this Ordinance is to repeal Ordinance No. 3046 adopted on January 28, 2013 so that the status quo can be maintained while this issue is subject to further study.

SECTION 3. THAT this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
