

ORDINANCE NO. 3056

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2990 AND 2993 BY CHANGING THE PAY STATUS FOR THE POLICE CAPTAIN'S POSITION FROM SALARIED TO HOURLY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, On January 9, 2012, this Council adopted Ordinance No. 2990 and January 23, 2012 passed Ordinance No. 2993, which established compensation and a table of organization for the Village of Crestline, and

WHEREAS, the position of Captain in the Police Department was classified as salaried in these Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, the Police and Fire Committee has recommended that the position of Police Captain be paid as an hourly position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Crestline hereby determines that the Captain of the Police Department will be paid at an hourly rate of nineteen dollars and eighty five cents (\$19.85) per hour and will be paid at an overtime rate of one and a half (1 ½) times the hourly rate for all hours worked in excess of 84 hours per fourteen day period and on holidays fixed by Ordinance which he/she works due to the normal work schedule for the department.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that so as to fairly compensate the Captain in the Police Department as soon as possible and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
