

COUNCIL MEETING
May 28, 2013

Council met this PM with the following members present: Miller, Bickert, Blaising, Gledhill, Herold, and Crokier. Six (6) yeas.

Mayor Sharrock presided over the meeting, which was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer by Mr. Welsh.

Motion by Bickert, second by Herold to approve minutes for April 22nd. Six (6) yeas. Motion by Gledhill, second by Blaising to approve minutes for May 13th. Six (6) yeas.

Motion by Miller, second by Herold to approve Agenda. Six (6) yeas.

Marc Milliron, Village Administrator – Mr. Milliron addresses the following: 1) Ord. 3060 read as an emergency due to monthly meetings. 2) Summary of pay rate increases forwarded to Mr. Herold. 3) Update on CDBG monies which are controlled by the county. 4) Hamilton Park restroom inspections. 5) Income surveys completed and the need for more to help obtain some funding for the village.

Harry Welsh, Law Director – Mr. Welsh discusses Ord. No. 3059 the need to add designer/synthetic drugs to the codified ordinances.

Streets, Public Buildings & Grounds, Mike Blaising – Mr. Blaising stated that a committee meeting held on May 23rd with discussion on the following: 1) Downtown parking and time limits- all agreed to keep as is. 2) Move “No Parking Sign” in the area of 384 Clink Blvd. back 1 ½ car lengths so that emergency vehicles, snow plows etc are able to get through. 3) Several complaints received about parking cars and pickup trucks on the grass in the 200 & 300 block of Clink Blvd. 4) Clean up high weeds on both sides of Paramore Creek.

Ordinance No. 3059 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 513.15, PROHIBITION ON THE USE, POSSESSION, AND SALE OF SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS AND OTHER SYNTHETIC DRUGS, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THIS VILLAGE BY ADDING THREE ADDITIONAL SYNTHETIC DRUGS TO THOSE PROHIBITED BY THIS SECTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. First reading held. Motion by Gledhill, second by Bickert for suspension of the rules for the second and third readings. Roll Call – Miller, Bickert, Blaising, Gledhill, Herold and Crokie. Six (6) yeas. Motion by Herold, second by Crokie for adoption. Roll Call – Miller, Bickert, Blaising, Gledhill, Herold, and Crokie. Six (6) yeas. Ordinance 3059 adopted.

Ordinance No. 3060 – AN ORDINANCE ENACTING CHAPTER 338 GOLF CARTS AS PART OF TITLE FIVE VEHICLES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THIS VILLAGE TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON PUBLIC STREETS BY LICENSED DRIVERS IN THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. First reading held. Motion by Bickert, second by Miller for suspension of the rules for the second and third readings. Roll Call – Miller, Bickert, Blaising, Gledhill, Herold and Crokie. Six (6) yeas. Motion by Crokie, Second by Herold for adoption. Roll Call – Bickert, Blaising, Gledhill, Herold, Crokie and Miller. Six (6) yeas. Ordinance No. 3060 adopted.
