

ORDINANCE NO. 3061

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 351.11 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THIS VILLAGE ENTITLED "PARKING IN ALLEYS AND NARROW STREETS" BY INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF AVAILABLE SPACE TO BE USED FOR FREE MOVEMENT OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FROM TEN TO FOURTEEN FEET.

WHEREAS, certain streets and alleys in the Village of Crestline are so narrow that the parking of one vehicle prohibits the use of that street or alley for rescue equipment and snow removal equipment, and

WHEREAS, Section 351.11(a) of the Codified Ordinances of this Village allows vehicles to park even though the street or alley is reduced in width to as little as ten feet, and

WHEREAS, the Street Committee has recommended that this provision be amended to adjust the available width to accommodate rescue, emergency, and snow removal equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 351.11(a) of the Codified Ordinances of this Village, which reads as follows:

- (a) No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon a street, other than an alley, in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the roadway for free movement of vehicular traffic, except that a driver may stop temporarily during the actual loading or unloading of passengers or when directed to by a police officer or traffic control signal.

is hereby repealed and enacted in its place is a new Section 351.11(a), which reads as follows:

- (a) No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon a street, other than an alley, in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than fourteen (14) feet of the width of the roadway for free movement of vehicular traffic, except that a driver may stop temporarily during the actual loading or unloading of passengers or when directed to by a police officer or traffic control signal.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
