

ORDINANCE NO. 3063

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE WEST LIVINGSTON STREET RESURFACING PROJECT, AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THIS WORK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Village will receive approximately \$22,000.00 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding from the Crawford County Commissioners for street resurfacing, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Council to use these funds to pay part of the cost of the West Livingston Street resurfacing project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for competitive bids for the West Livingston Street resurfacing project in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in his office. That provide a satisfactory bid is received for this work, the Village Administrator is directed to award a contract to perform this work to the lowest and best bidder as provided by law.

SECTION 2. THAT the Fiscal Officer is authorized to pay for this work from the funds received under the CDBG program first and then the balance from the appropriate account in the Village Street Fund.

SECTION 3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that the immediate authority to proceed with the Project is necessary so it can be completed during the current construction season and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
