

ORDINANCE NO. 3067

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3055 KNOWN AS THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR 2013 BY APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEY FOR PART-TIME LABOR AND SWIMMING POOL ACCOUNTS IN THE VILLAGE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, David Keller who is the Village Law Director for the criminal cases has elected to purchase credit from the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) for his public service in 1992, and

WHEREAS, he has paid both the employer and the employers share and all interest owed thereon to this Village for a total payment of \$3,279.68 and

WHEREAS, this money must be appropriated so that it can be paid to OPERS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That within the Village General Fund the appropriation for part-time labor (101.114) is hereby increased by the sum of \$3,279.68 for the purpose of making the payment to OPERS on behalf of David Keller.

SECTION 2. That within the General Fund, the sum of \$2,600.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated serves to the Swimming Pool account as follows:

SECTION 3. That the Ordinance being for the appropriation of money for current expenses shall go into immediate effect pursuant O.R.C. 731.30.
