

ORDINANCE NO. 3071

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3055 KNOWN AS THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR 2013 BY INCREASING THE APPROPRIATION IN THE GENERAL FUND, STREET FUND, WATER FUND, SEWER FUND, AND THE AMBULANCE FUND.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT within the Village General Fund the sum of \$110,166.67 is hereby appropriated from un-appropriated reserves to the following Accounts.

SECTION 2. THAT within the Streets Fund the sum of \$30,000.00 is hereby appropriated from un-appropriated reserves as follows:

SECTION 3. THAT within the Water Fund the sum of \$17,000.00 is hereby appropriated from un-appropriated reserves as follows:

SECTION 4. THAT within the Sewer Fund the sum of \$100,000.00 is hereby appropriated from un-appropriated reserves as follows:
