

RESOLUTION NO. 17-50

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF RESOLUTION 17-47 TO REMOVE THE REFERENCE TO CRAWFORD COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, R.C. 5705.16 was amended October 1, 2016, to no longer require the Court's approval of the transfer of funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Resolution 17-47 shall read as follows:

The Village Law Director is directed to prepare and file the Petition with the Tax Commissioner of the State of Ohio as required by R.C. 5705.16.

SECTION 2. That the original Section 2 of Resolution 17-47 is repealed.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to update the resolution for purposes of filing and completing the Fund Transfer and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
