

RESOLUTION NO. 17-51

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE APPLICATION FOR A SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT OF THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR FIREFIGHTERS' EXPOSURE TO ENVIRONMENTAL ELEMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,257.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to sign and complete the Application for Safety Intervention Grant with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for Firefighters' Exposure to Environmental Elements in the amount of \$9,257.00 according to the terms and conditions approved by Council.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide protective clothing and equipment to Village firefighters, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
