

RESOLUTION NO. 16-18

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN ENCROACHMENT EASEMENT AGREEMENT GRANTING AN EASEMENT TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE CRESTLINE EXEMPT VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to grant an easement to the Board of Education of the Crestline Exempted Village School District according to the terms and conditions of the Encroachment Easement Agreement as received and approved by Council.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to coordinate the grant of the easement with the Village's purchase of several Inlots from the school district and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
