

RESOLUTION NO. 16-19

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A REAL ESTATE TRANSFER AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CRESTLINE EXEMPTED VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE PURCHASE OF PARCELS CONSTITUTING ALL OR SUBSTANTIALLY ALL OF VILLAGE INLOTS 1069 AND 1113-1116, EXCLUDING THE VACATED LIVINGSTON AVENUE RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to enter into the Real Estate Transfer Agreement with the Board of Education of the Crestline Exempted Village School District for the Village's purchase for One Dollar (\$1.00) of all or substantially all of Village Inlots 1069 and 1113-1116, but excluding the vacated Livingston Avenue right-of-way as reviewed and approved by Council.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to proceed with the redevelopment of the former athletic field, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
