## **RESOLUTION NO. 16-40**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CRAWFORD COUNTY LAND REUTILIZATION CORPORATION (CCLRC OR LAND BANK), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Director of the CCLRC OR LAND BANK has the authority, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC), to enter into grant agreements with state and local government agencies. The CCLRC OR LAND BANK may use the money in the fund to remediate conditions at a location that the Crawford County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC) has reason to believe has a nuisance requiring abatement pursuant to R.C. 1724.02(J), and

WHEREAS, the CCLRC OR LAND BANK wishes to enter into an Agreement to reclaim, rehabilitate or reutilize and clear titles of delinquent and vacant properties in several targeted areas of Crawford County in accordance with R.C. Sections 1724.01(B)(2) and 1724.02 and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline desires to perform and complete such work, activities, and requirements as prescribed by CCLRC OR LAND BANK.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the agreement with the Crawford County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC) including the grant providing 1.7 Million Dollars toward the Crawford County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC) to remediate conditions at a location that the Crawford County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC) has reason to believe has a nuisance requiring abatement.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that

the immediate authority to sign this agreement in order to proceed in accordance with the established time schedule, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
