## **RESOLUTION NO. 17-19**

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE CLOSURE OF THE PARKS DISC GOLF COURSE AND FOR THE RETURN OF THE EQUIPMENT AND DONATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Park Committee met on July 17, 2017 and it is their recommendation to end the disc golf course project and to return the donations that have accumulated to a total value of Eight Thousand Six Hundred Fifty and 05/100 Dollars (\$8,650.05), and

WHEREAS, the Park Committee further recommends that the Mayor search for a buyer to purchase the nineteen-disc golf baskets. Council finds the estimated value of the equipment is less than \$1,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the disc golf course project be closed as follows:

- a) That all donors to the disc golf course shall have their full donation returned to them by certified postage.
- b) That any donor that is not in receipt of such donation and/or the check is either returned through postage or the check does not clear within the allotted time, then the Village's Fiscal Officer shall deposit such funds into the unclaimed funds fund.
- SECTION 2. That the Mayor of the Village shall within reason try to sell such equipment that has been purchased, such as the nineteen baskets that are within the Village's inventory, for a value that shall be approved by the majority vote of Council.
- SECTION 3. That the Mayor of the Village shall allow within reason for Rob Shawber to enter the premises known as the site for the Crestline Disc Golf Course to remove such material that he has personally supplied for the construction of the disc golf course.
- SECTION 4. That the Village Fiscal Officer shall document the final distribution from the closure of the Disc Golf Course project in preparation of the Village's Audit.

SECTION 5. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to have closure on this project, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
