

ORDINANCE NO. 3096

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE COUNTYLINE WATERLINE INSTALLATION, AUTHORIZING THE AWARDED OF A CONTRACT PROVIDED A SATISFACTORY BID IS RECEIVED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village submitted for financial assistance and received financial assistance from Ohio Public Works Commission and was awarded on July 1, 2014 for the installation and completion of the Countyline Waterline, and

WHEREAS, all steps have been completed which are necessary to proceed to seek competitive bids for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for competitive bids for the Countyline Waterline improvements in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Makeever & Associates, Inc., which are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. THAT provided a satisfactory bid is received the Village Administrator is authorized to award a contract to the lowest and best bidder as provided by law.

SECTION 3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that

the immediate authority to advertise for bids and award a contract is necessary so that this project can proceed in accordance with the established time schedule and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
