

ORDINANCE NO. 3113

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING GENERAL FUND ALLOCATIONS OF POLICE K-9 FUNDS, POLICE AUXILIARY FUNDS AND VOLUNTEER FIREMAN FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief is in the process of raising funds to secure the need of a K-9 unit and therefore needs to allocate monies to be used specifically for that purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief is in the process of raising funds to support his auxiliary officers, and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief is in the process of raising funds to support his volunteer staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Police Chief is assigned account #215.44900 to receive revenue monies toward the K-9 unit, in return appropriation account #215.210.53905 will be used for expenditures. That the Police K-9 Fund is hereby established specifically for the receipt, allocation and transfer of such funding.

SECTION 2. That the Police Chief is assigned account #817.44900 to receive revenue monies for financial support and maintenance of the police auxiliary force, in return appropriation account #817.210.53905 will be used for expenditures. That the Police Auxiliary Fund is hereby established specifically for the receipt, allocation and transfer of such funding.

SECTION 3. That the Fire Chief is assigned account #815.44900 to receive revenue monies for financial support and maintenance of volunteer fireman staff, in return appropriation account #815.220.53905 will be used for expenditures. That the Volunteer Staff Fund is hereby established specifically for the receipt, allocation and transfer of such funding.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby determined that this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to reconcile Police and Fire special revenue funds and its allocation to Village Funds, and this ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
