

ORDINANCE NO. 3115

AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING A CONTRACT TO STATEWIDE FORD LINCOLN, INC. OF VAN WERT, OHIO, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 2016 FORD EXPLORER FOR THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE SUM OF \$38,403.00 THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Village participates in the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program authorized by R.C. 125.04 which allows this Village to purchase equipment at state bid prices without the necessity of the Village seeking competitive bids, and

WHEREAS, motor vehicles for the Police Department which meet the requirements of this Village are available through this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT a contract is hereby awarded to Statewide Ford Lincoln, Inc. of Van Wert, Ohio, for the purchase of one 2016 Ford Explorer under State Bid Contract for the Village Police Department for the total sum of Thirty Eight Thousand four hundred three dollars (\$38,403.00) through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. THAT the Village Fiscal Officer is directed to increase the appropriations for the Police and Fire Capital monies by Thirty Eight Thousand five hundred dollars (\$38,500.00) from an unappropriated reserve account known as the Police and Fire Capital revenue to pay for this vehicle.

SECTION 3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,

safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the acquisition of this vehicle as soon as possible is necessary so that the level of police protection can be maintained, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
