

ORDINANCE NO. 3132

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLIC SALE OF UNNEEDED OR OBSOLETE VILLAGE-OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owns numerous and miscellaneous personal property that is no longer needed and/or obsolete for Village service, and

WHEREAS, such property requires storage and deteriorates without use, and

WHEREAS, the sale of such personal property is its best use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the personal property listed in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto, is no longer needed or is obsolete and has an estimated value greater than One Thousand Dollars.

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator is directed to advertise the public sale of such personal property for two weeks.

SECTION 3. That the Village Administrator is authorized to sell such personal property upon written consent to the highest and best bidder for each item of personal property.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that

there is an immediate need to prevent deterioration and loss of value of said property, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
