

ORDINANCE NO. 3137

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES FOR PLACEMENT WITHIN THE VILLAGE'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND TO ADOPT AMENDMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC, GENERAL OFFENSE, AND FIRE PREVENTION PROVISIONS OF THE VILLAGE'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Crestline, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, numerous sections of the Traffic, General Offenses, and Fire Prevention Codes should be updated to comply with enactments passed by the General Assembly in the past year.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Crestline, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 3. Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to ensure the most up-to-date codified ordinances are available to our judicial system, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
