

ORDINANCE NO. 3148

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.05, PERSONAL APPEARANCE/CLOTHING ALLOWANCE, AND SECTION 3.22, REIMBURSEMENT OF UNIFORM, OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL (PPM), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2012, Crestline Village Council passed Ordinance No. 2992, thereby adopting a revised Policies and Procedures Manual (PPM) for the Village of Crestline, and

WHEREAS, the Police and Fire Committee of the Village of Crestline has recommended revision of the following sections of the PPM: Section 7.05, the clothing allowance for police officers to include bulletproof vest coverage, and Section 3.22, employee reimbursement toward any uniform purchases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 7.05 of the Village's Policies and Procedures Manual is amended to provide a maximum employee allowance of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the purchase of a bulletproof vest every five (5) years of Village employment.

SECTION 2. That Section 3.22 of the Village's Policies and Procedures Manual is amended to require any employee that leaves Village employment shall reimburse the Village for its cost of providing a bulletproof vest less the amount of one-sixtieth (1/60) for each month of continuous service performed after receiving the vest.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that for the safety of the police officers that serve in this Village the immediate effective date of this Ordinance is necessary, and shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
