

ORDINANCE NO. 3155

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE CHIEF OF POLICE  
SALE OF OBSOLETE AND UNFIT POLICE DEPARTMENT  
FIREARMS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Department has eleven (11) Village-owned firearms that are obsolete and unfit for police officer use which combined exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Chief of Police is authorized to sell the Village-owned firearms that are obsolete and/or unfit for department use to-wit: nine (9) Smith & Wesson M&P40 pistols and two (2) Remington 870 twelve gauge shotguns by one bid to the highest and best bidder.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that the Village has an upcoming sale of firearms which will benefit the financing of Village law enforcement, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
