

RESOLUTION NO. 15-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SELL WOOD LOGS HAVING AN ESTIMATED VALUE OF LESS THAN 1,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has cut trees in its Municipal Park leaving several large logs and not needed by the Village, and

WHEREAS, an immediate sale of the logs will clear the park and insure the highest value for the logs, and

WHEREAS, the estimated value of the logs is less than One Thousand Dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is authorized to sell the wood logs cut from park property.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is a necessity to clear the parks and to protect the value of the wood and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
