

RESOLUTION NO. 15-22

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CRAWFORD PARK DISTRICT'S DECISION REQUESTING TO APPLY FOR OPWC CLEAN OHIO FUND-GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION PROGRAM TO ACQUIRE ADDITIONAL LAND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Crawford Park District is in the process of applying to the Ohio Public Works Commission, Clean Ohio Fund-Green Space Conservation program for a grant to acquire approximately 30 acres of land that will be preserved for the citizens of Crawford County, and the State of Ohio which will become part of Lowe-Volk Park.

WHEREAS, said land is Crawford County Parcel No. 25-006121.000 currently owned by the Donald and Betty J. Tucker Trust and is located west of St. Rt. 598/south of CR 229, and

WHEREAS, this property is part of the Sandusky River corridor with bottom land that is important ecologically as a riparian buffer zone, natural flood management area, wildlife habitat and that area citizens use Crawford Park District's Lowe-Volk Park for varied nature enjoyment activities which improves the quality of life here.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Crestline, Crawford County, Ohio hereby supports the Crawford County Park District's effort to purchase this addition to Lowe-Volk Park.



That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
