

RESOLUTION NO. 16- 09

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMITMENT OF THE VILLAGE HOUSING HOME PROGRAM INCOME TO THE 2016 CRAWFORD COUNTY CHIP GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has the opportunity to receive two Owner Rehabilitation Project funding in 2016 by participating in the 2016 Crawford County CHIP Grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Village Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to commit the Village's Housing HOME Program Income to the 2016 Crawford County CHIP Grant provided the Village receives the commitment for two Owner Rehabilitation Projects to be completed in the Village in 2016.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to seek approval of the offer of the rehabilitation projects, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
