

Notes:

- 1) "Driveway" means the principle means of egress, not exceeding twenty four (24) feet in width, into a property from the traveled portion of a road right of way, which shall be improved with concrete, asphalt or other materials, provided however, that such driveway shall not occupy over forty percent (40%) of the total width of the lot. Driveways shall be designed so as to be located as much as possible in available side yards and may encroach upon a front yard only where there is insufficient width under the standards set forth in this definition to place the drive in the side yard completely.
- 2) Driveway width may vary but the taper stays the same 3' by 6'
- 3) Driveway approach must be 6" reinforced concrete over compacted 4" base / or 6 inches asphalt paving over 4" compacted base.
- 4) Sidewalk adjacent to drive must be 6" reinforced concrete
- 5) Is area located within the designated flood plain area. If so, initiate a Flood Hazard Development Permit Application.
