The parade is always a great opportunity to showcase your organization while joining with the entire community for some great family fun at the festival! All parade entries are encouraged to decorate their floats as we will be judging floats and giving prizes to 1st and 2nd place. In addition, school bands that participate will receive a donation toward their band program.

The Crestline Harvest Festival will begin on Thursday, September 19th and will last through Saturday, September 21st. The parade will be held on Saturday, September 21st, 2019.

***New in 2019 – For everyone’s safety, parade participants are strictly prohibited from throwing candy from a vehicle during the parade. All participants may pass out candy by walking the parade perimeter.**

Listed below are the details regarding participation in the 2019 Crestline Harvest Festival Parade. Please read these details carefully as we continue to implement changes to the operation of the parade.

- The parade will be lined up in the order the entries are received. If you need your unit to be at the beginning of the parade, please submit your application promptly.
- Only Pre-Registered Parade Entries will be permitted in the Parade! If you do not pre-register, you will be turned away or placed at the end of the parade.
- You must file an application to participate in the parade. Parade applications are available at Crestline Village Hall during the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm, Monday-Friday or on the Village of Crestline website www.crestlineoh.com

- All pre-registered units will receive written confirmation.
- The 2019 Crestline Harvest Festival Parade will go rain or shine... there will be NO rain date. If severe or dangerous weather is present on the date of the parade, the parade may be cancelled.
- Parade line-up will begin at 1:00pm on Park Rd. All parade units must enter the parade line-up route at the intersection of Park Rd. and W. Main St. The intersection on Park Rd. and W. Bucyrus St. will be blocked off, as well as all side streets that lead into Park Rd. NO traffic will be permitted beyond these road closures! Crestline Harvest Festival Committee members will be present in the area to assist you to your location in the line-up.
- Parade participants not arriving with their parade unit can be dropped off at the intersection of Maple Dr. and Park Rd. or at the intersection of W. Bucyrus St. and Park Rd. We ask that you drop off participants and exit the area as soon as possible.
- All parade participants must be in line-up position **by** 3:00pm as the parade will start ***promptly*** at 3:30pm!
