PARADE APPLICATION

The Crestline Harvest Festival Committee would like to extend an invitation to your organization to participate in the 2021 Crestline Harvest Festival Parade. The parade is always a great opportunity to showcase your organization while joining with the entire community for some great family fun at the festival!

The Crestline Harvest Festival will begin on Thursday, September 16th and will last through Saturday, September 18th. The parade will be held on Saturday at 3:30 p.m.

Listed below are the details regarding participation in the 2021 Crestline Harvest Festival Parade. Please read these details carefully as we continue to implement changes to the operation of the parade.

- The parade will be lined up in the order the entries are received as well as spacing differentiation based on the type of entry. If you need your unit to be at the beginning of the parade, please submit your application promptly.
- We encourage only pre-registered parade entries to be permitted in the parade. If you do not pre-register, you will be turned away or placed at the end of the parade.
- You must file an application to participate in the parade. Parade applications are available at Crestline Village Hall during the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday-Friday or on the Village of Crestline website www.crestlineoh.com
- All parade entries with floats are encouraged to decorate them as we will have judges to award prizes for 1st and 2nd places, based on workmanship, materials, special effects, and appearances. The winners will be announced at the main stage at 6:30 p.m. after the parade and in The Advocate the following week. (Winners are not required to be present at the time of recognition). In addition, school bands that participate will receive a donation toward their band programs.

- All pre-registered units will receive confirmation via postal mail or email acknowledging your application receipt. Please provide an email address for confirmation of receipt of your parade entry as well as possible changes to operations prior to the event.
- The 2021 Crestline Harvest Festival Parade will go rain or shine... there will be NO rain date. However, if severe or dangerous weather is present on the date of the parade, the parade may be cancelled.
- Parade line-up will begin at 1:00 p.m. on Park Road, spanning from Kelly Park to Maple Drive. All parade units must enter the parade line-up route at the intersection of Park Road and West Main Street. (The intersection at Park Road and West Bucyrus Street will be blocked off, as well as all side streets that lead into Park Road). NO traffic will be permitted beyond these road closures. Crestline Harvest Festival Committee Members will be present in the area to assist you to your location in the line-up.
- Parade participants not arriving with their parade unit can be dropped off at the intersection of Maple Drive and Park Road or at the intersection of West Bucyrus Street and Park Road. We ask that you drop off participants and exit the area as soon as possible.
- Due to safety concerns, NO candy may be thrown from a vehicle this year. Please pass out candy by walkers only.
- All parade participants must be in line-up position *by* 3:00 p.m. as the parade will start *promptly* at 3:30 p.m.!
