

PARKS & RECREATION NOTICE

The Village of Crestline is investing in its future for the Parks and Recreation areas. Plans for the 2023 year are to clean and clear Paramour Creek along Kelly Park, draining and reinforcing the walls of Jaycee Pond, and major structural upgrades to the Municipal Swimming Pool.



Beginning on March 1st, the Village began draining Jaycee Pond. The pond will be closed for the 2023 year while work is completed. Crews will be cleaning the bank areas, dredging and cleaning the pond basin, and reinforcing the partially collapsed wall along Paramour Creek. The closing of the pond for repairs is not ideal but must be done to keep the pond for future generations. The pond area will be closed until further notice. Programs like Cops N Bobbers and the VFW Huck Finn Day will be relocated to the pond at the Crestline Water

Treatment Plant for the 2023 year.

The Crestline Swimming Pool will also most likely be closed for the 2023 season for major upgrades. Upgrades include electrical, structural and aesthetic. The project is being planned to be started as soon as the village receives updated pricing for bidding the project. If the project is completed prior to the end of warm weather in August, the plan will be to open the pool free to the public for the limited time remaining for the season.
