Ordinance No. 3079 – AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE SANITARY SEWER PLANT IMPROVEMENTS, AUTHORIZING THE AWARDED OF A CONTRACT PROVIDED A SATISFACTORY BID IS RECEIVED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Ordinance No. 3080 – AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AT PUBLIC AUCTION OF FOUR PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THIS VILLAGE WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. First reading held. Motion by Taylor, second by Wampler for suspension of the rules for second and third readings. Roll Call – Taylor, Blaising, Wampler, Mahek, Herold and Buckner. Six (6) yeas. Motion by Herold, second by Wampler for adoption. Roll Call – Wampler, Mahek, Herold, Buckner, Taylor, and Blaising. Six (6) yeas. Ordinance No. 3080 adopted.
