

ORDINANCE NO. 3025

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE PERMANENT APPOINTMENT OF JOSEPH BUTLER AS CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of this Village has heretofore appointed Joseph Butler as the Chief of Police for a probationary period of six months, and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2012, this Council by Ordinance No. 2999 duly confirmed this appointment, and

WHEREAS, six months have passed since the confirmation of this appointment, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has transmitted to this Council a record of Chief Butler's service during his probationary period and has recommended that he be permanently appointment as the Chief of Police of this Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the permanent appointment of Joseph Butler as the Chief of Police of the Village of Crestline effective immediately is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate effective date of this Ordinance is necessary so as to provide stability and continuity to the operation of the Village Police Department, and

shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
