

ORDINANCE NO. 3101

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE TO CONTRACT WITH RINEHART-WALTERS-DANNER INSURANCE AGENCY IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THE VILLAGE WITH CASUALTY, PROPERTY AND LIABILITY INSURANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Crestline must have a contract for Casualty, Property and Liability insurance, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline desires to hire Rinehart-Walters-Danner Insurance Agency to provide the Village of Crestline with Casualty, Property and Liability insurance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Crestline, Ohio:

SECTION 1 That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village of Crestline shall contract Rinehart-Walters-Danner Insurance Agency to provide the Village of Crestline with Casualty, Property and Liability insurance.

SECTION 2 That the services contracted will cost the Village of Crestline forty two thousand three hundred twenty dollars and no cents, (\$42,320.00), for one year.

SECTION 3 That it is hereby determined that this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of residents in this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to ensure timely contractual agreement and this ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council; otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
