

ORDINANCE NO. 3121

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH KELSTIN, INC. TO PERFORM THE OLDFIELD ROAD AND COYER ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in order for The Village of Crestline to make the necessary improvements to Oldfield and Coyer Road a contractor must be hired, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline desires to hire Kelstin, Inc. to conduct the necessary construction services for Oldfield and Coyer Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Crestline, Ohio:

SECTION 1 That the Village Administrator of the Village of Crestline shall contract with Kelstin, Inc. to conduct the necessary construction services for Oldfield and Coyer Road.

SECTION 2 That the services contracted are awarded to the lowest bidder on this project the sum of One Hundred One thousand Three hundred dollars and Zero cents, (\$101,300.00).

SECTION 3 That professional services are needed for the management of this project, we shall contract with Makeever and Associates to be the project coordinator on this project for the sum of Ten thousand dollars and Zero cents, (\$10,000.00).

SECTION 4. That it is hereby determined that this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to maintain required schedule with Crestline Exempted School district in order to minimize local traffic during such construction period, and this ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
