

ORDINANCE NO. 3122

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3114 KNOWN AS THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR 2015 AS AMENDED BY INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS IN CERTAIN ACCOUNTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council approved the Police Chief to refund monies from the K-9 fund to their appropriate donors, and

WHEREAS, the recent audit has clarified the use of OPWC monies and the requirements for the distribution of money for such projects, and

WHEREAS, in 2014 the Crestline Police Department received extensive damage to certain areas of the Police Department due to the extreme weather conditions causing water pipes above the police department to rupture damaging computers, lighting, flooring, office furniture, sprinkler system and other miscellaneous items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT the appropriation of funds to the Law Enforcement and Education Fund #214 is increased from \$16,548.50 to \$17,048.50 due to the receipt of additional revenue.

SECTION 2. THAT the appropriation of funds to the OPWC Fund #260 is increased from \$0.00 to \$373,427.00 due to the receipt of new revenue.

SECTION 3. THAT the appropriation of funds to the Police & Fire Capital Fund #360.00.49303 is increased from \$91,823.00 to \$105,255.22 due to the receipt of additional revenue.

SECTION 4. THAT this Ordinance being for appropriation of money for current expenses shall go into immediate effect pursuant to O.R.C. 731.30.
