

ORDINANCE NO. 3124

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 3013 BY ESTABLISHING A CHARGE FOR REFUSALS FOR RESCUE AND EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE AND NON-EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2012, by Ordinance No. 3013 this Council established the rates for rescue and emergency ambulance service and non-emergency ambulance transportation service, and

WHEREAS, Police and Fire Committee met for discussion to add to the legislation a charge for refusals within the Village of Crestline and contracted areas, and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of this Council to charge for refusals for emergency ambulance service and non-emergency ambulance services so that adjustments in that rate will automatically be applied to the rates established by Ordinance No. 3013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT Section 1 of Ordinance 3013 is amended by the addition of the following New Rate and Charge:

Refusals for rescue and emergency ambulance Service and non-emergency ambulance services.	\$50.00

SECTION 2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that

the immediate effective date of this ordinance is necessary so as to allow adjustments in the rates set by Ordinance No. 3013 to become effective as soon as possible in order to preserve the fiscal integrity of the Village ambulance fund and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
