

RESOLUTION NO. 13-10

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF ANDREW ROYSTON AS A FULL-TIME PROBATIONARY POLICE OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of this Village, upon the recommendation of the Police Chief, has appointed Andrew Royston as a full-time probationary police officer, and

WHEREAS, in order to be effective, this appointment must be confirmed by this Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the appointment of Andrew Royston as a full-time police officer of this Village for a probationary period of six (6) months is hereby confirmed effective immediately.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of this Village, and for the further reason the immediate effective date of this Resolution is necessary so as to have an additional officer available to provide coverage, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
