

RESOLUTION NO. 16-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SEEK COMPETITIVE ESTIMATES TO HAVE A CONTRACTOR CRUSH CONCRETE AND ASPHALT FOR THE MAKING OF GRAVEL AND AUTHORIZING HIM TO AWARD A CONTRACT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has a couple of stone/concrete dump sites that have accumulated over the years and at this time the need for crushed gravel has arisen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is authorized to seek written estimates to have our rock piles crushed and stockpiled and award a contract to precede with crushed gravel in 2016 to the lowest and best bidder, subject to the Village's available funds.

SECTION 2. That the process of the project is estimated to be \$15,000.00 of which the Village of Crestline commits to pay from Sewer and Water capital, also some funds may be available within the street capital.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate authority to advertise for bids and award a contract is necessary so that this project can proceed in accordance with the established time schedule and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3)

vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
