

RESOLUTION NO. 16-41

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CRESTLINE HISTORICAL SOCIETY AS IT RELOCATES INTO A MORE PRACTICAL BUILDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Crestline Historical Society has been part of the Crestline Community for more than 69 years and over 63 years the Crestline Historical Society has been using the John Q. Shunk home as its Museum, and

WHEREAS, this structure built in the 1860's has extended its usefulness and as the Crestline Historical Society outgrows the building with additional artifacts it is time to relocate to a more practical place, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Council that it supports the Crestline Historical Society's needs for growth and its need to relocate to a more practical building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby supports the endeavors of the Crestline Historical Society in connection with its proposed development plans to maintain the artifacts of the Crestline community.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution is intended to support the application of the Crestline Historical Society as it seeks necessary funding toward the future development and growth.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate authority to sign this agreement in order to proceed in accordance with the established time schedule, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council,

otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
