

RESOLUTION NO. 17-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT TO FUND A NON-SEWER AREA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Commissioners are allowing local communities to participate in their Community Development Block Grant for the purpose of allocating funds to help low / moderate income level neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crestline, Crawford County, has a need for such funding that will be useful in an area that is non-sewer area located on parts of W. Livingston Avenue, and

WHEREAS, if the County Commissioners find this project to meet their criteria, such funding will be made available for program year 2017/2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is authorized on behalf of the Village of Crestline to submit a CDBG application to the County Commissioners to fund a portion of W. Livingston Avenue un-sewer area.

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator is further authorized to enter into an agreement with Makeever and Associates to be the lead engineer on this project at an estimated cost not to exceed Six Thousand dollars (\$6,000.00)

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that passage is necessary to meet the application deadline date, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
