

RESOLUTION NO. 17-23

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE REMOVAL OF THE BUILDING LOCATED AT 111 N. WASHINGTON AVE. AND TO UTILIZE R.C. 3929.86 INSURANCE PROCEEDS TO COVER THE COSTS OF REMOVAL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, R.C. 715.26 authorizes the removal of insecure and unsafe buildings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is authorized and directed to demolish and remove the building(s) located at 111 N. Washington Ave. due to the insecure and unsafe conditions.

SECTION 2. That R.C. 3929.86 insurance proceeds of \$16,467.70 received by the Village shall be used to cover all costs incurred to demolish, remove and secure the property and to return it to a safe condition in keeping with Village codes and ordinances.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to correct this public nuisance and prevent risk of harm, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
