

RESOLUTION NO. 17-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BUCYRUS ROAD MATERIALS TO MAKE NECESSARY STREET IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Crestline, Crawford County is planning to make capital improvements to parts of W. Main Street by repairing the pavement caused by the installation of a new water service line.

Whereas, The water and sewer committee met and discussed the need to resurface the south lane of W. Main Street from N. Wiley street to the corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator of the Village of Crestline is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Bucyrus Road Materials to make capital improvements to sections of W. Main Street by resurfacing the pavement.

SECTION 2. That an estimated project cost of Thirty-Four Thousand One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$34,150.00) is needed to complete the W. Main Street resurfacing project.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents and further to assist with time restraints caused by weather conditions, shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to

this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
