

RESOLUTION NO. 17-48

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO CONTRACT FOR THE SERVICES OF A SUBSTITUTE MAYOR'S COURT MAGISTRATE AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in the absence of the Village's only Mayor's Court magistrate, the Village cannot conduct its Mayor's Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTLINE, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract for the services of a substitute Mayor's Court magistrate with the same hourly compensation paid to the Village's regular magistrate.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the immediate effective date of this resolution is necessary so as to allow the current Magistrate to have coverage while absent and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
